# **Shepherd's Pie Check** Google for recipe of your choice



Shepherd's pie, cottage pie, or in French cuisine hachis Parmentier, is a sayoury dish of cooked minced meat topped with mashed potato and baked, also called anders or Saunders. The meat used may be either previously cooked or freshly minced. The usual meats are beef or lamb. The terms shepherd's pie and cottage pie have been used interchangeably since they came into use in the late 18th and early 19th centuries, although some writers insist that a shepherd's pie should contain lamb or mutton, and a cottage pie, beef.

Growing up in California, my mother was an amazing gardener and inspired me to continue my love of gardening. Sometimes, not always willingly, but under duress, I always helped plant a spring vegetable garden. We always had Beefsteak tomatoes and a ton of Zucchini. Our neighbors were always supplied with Zucchini, Pumpkins, String beans, and big favorites.

My mother also loved basket-flowering plants and cut flowers, such as the most beautiful Dahlias, Roses, tuberous Begonias, an assortment of hanging Fuchsias, and chrysanthemums in the fall.

I have always had some kind of vegetable garden as fresh is best.

My wife bought some orchids in the early 1980s beautiful, but we had no clue how to take care of them. I saw orchids die and become ugly. I decided I had to do something, so I joined the Peninsula Orchid Society and started to learn some of the orchid basics. A whole new world opened. I got involved with professional growers and extreme hobbyists. Orchids exchanged hands, and most were traded and given away. The collection grew, but how do you care for orchids in the kitchen? Not easy.

We built a greenhouse, and I wired and connected it to water and gas for heat.

This means I am not a Master Gardener or extreme hobbyist. I am just a big fan of orchids and willing to pass on some hard-learned lessons. My plants have won many blue ribbons and some best-of-show awards.

An old timer once told me you have to kill a thousand orchids before you learn. In other words, it is a science experiment dependent on your home conditions and the orchid selections you make that fit your lifestyle.




